HOW IT WORKS:

- It's FREE to come and participate and sell your goods. We will have tables and chairs available.
- No commitment required – participate as you would like throughout the season.
- We want to keep our Farmer's Market focused on locally grown, gathered, prepared and hand-crafted items. We are not accepting any vendors selling commercial or imported items. No franchises or non-owner operated businesses. Thank you for your understanding!
- Encouraged goods: vegetables, fruits, starts, flowers, soaps, homespun yarn, arts and crafts, etc.
- There will be a community table set up to donate items, share excess and take whatever you need.
- If you have items you want to sell, but do not want to attend the market, connect with us and we can figure out how our committee members may help sell for you.
- The Health Department has stricter permitting requirements for items such as meat, eggs, dairy, honey and baked goods. If you do not already have those appropriate permits to sell these items, our Farmer's Market is unable to provide those permits for our vendors.
- Foods allowed to be sold - whole fruits and vegetables, processed, packaged food that does not require temperature control for safety, dry not-ready-to-eat foods and foods you are selling under a Cottage Food Permit – **PLEASE PROVIDE A COPY OF PERMIT(S) WITH YOUR REGISTRATION.**
- Foods not allowed to be sold - any foods that require temperature control, ready-to-eat foods, sampling, baked items (unless the vendor has a Cottage Foods Permit with WSDA), and mobile food trucks. We are unable to accommodate food vendors at this time and there will be no food prep allowed on site.
- Please arrive at 9:30am to set up and be completed by 10am.
- No Smoking at the Grays River Grange Market or anywhere on the premises/property.
- Well-mannered pets-on-leash are allowed provided owners clean up after their pets. Children must be supervised at all times during the market.
- Disposing of Trash - you are responsible for keeping your space clean and the removal of all trash at end of the day. We ask that you take your own trash with you when you leave.
