It's free to join and you can sign-up at the door the night of the event. All participants are considered 'members' of the group. A participant is any member who attends this event. This includes but is not limited to anyone coming to offer items and services, anyone coming to shop or browse items and services, and/or any guests and/or minors they bring with them. The Grays River Grange is presenting a night of summer solstice celebration with a potluck, Jam Walk and an opportunity to barter unique goods related to your farms, gardens and kitchens!

WHEN: *Thursday, June 19th*

TIME: *5:00 pm – 8:00 pm*

WHERE: *Grays River Grange – 11 Hull Creek Road, Grays River, WA 98621*

ALLOWED ITEMS TO BARTER:

- Books related to farming, gardening, livestock, etc.
- Labeled crop starts, plants, bulbs and/or seeds (please label them, providing as much information as possible)
- Home-grown produce
- Home-canned goods including preserves, produce, honey, sourdough starts, kombucha mothers (scooby), meads, wine, fish, jerky, etc.
- Home-made goods including soaps, textiles, baked goods, etc.
- New and gently used canning supplies, fruit presses, apple corers, dehydrators, etc.
- New and gently used tools and implements (*see notes below*)
- New and gently used lawn and garden equipment (*see notes below*)
- Fleeces and fibers, roving, spun fiber
- Livestock and poultry (*see notes below*)
- Houseplants and houseplant supplies
- Anything livestock/poultry related: goat milk soap, homemade cheese, eggs, etc.
- Arts and crafts created with home-made or home-grown products
- Farm, Garden or Kitchen labor and resources

NOTES:

- Yes, you can still come to the event if you have nothing to barter – participate in the Potluck and Jam Walk!
- This event will be BARTER ONLY, no cash, no vending. Do not bring yard/garage sale items.
- There will be a FREE community table set up for goods you want to give-away.
- If you have a larger item or resource, please don't bring it to the event. It can be written down and bartered or shared as an IOU.
- Livestock and poultry can be bartered as an IOU – don't bring animals to the event.
- Firewood, livestock feed, cages, coops, hutches, runs, tanks, nesting boxes, small incubators, brooders, feed containers, water containers can be bartered as an IOU.
